Covenant Reminder

No dwelling house, garage, fence, wall or other structures upon any portion of said property shall be erected or constructed, and no alterations which would materially alter the exterior appearance of any such structures shall be made unless a complete set of plans and specification. Therefor, including the exterior color scheme, together with a block plan indicating the exact location on the building site shall have been submitted to an approved in writing by the Homeowners Association, and a copy of such plans as finally approved deposited for permanent record with the Association. Said plans and specifications shall be submitted in writing for approval, over the signature of the owner of the building site or over the signature of his duly authorized agent, on a form satisfactory to the Association. The approval of said plans and specifications may be withheld not only because of their noncompliance with any of the specific conditions, covenants and restrictions contained in this Declaration, but sto be erected. No provisions herein contained shall or structures within the common or recreational areas.

STOP SPEEDERS!!

The speed limit in Cross Creek is 25 m.p.h. Please maintain the self and report those you observe breaking this the Sheriff's office will send. also because of the dissatisfaction of the Association with any or all other matters or things which, in the judgment of the Association, would render the proposed structure inharmonious with the general plan of improvement of said property or with the structure erected on other building sites in the immediate vicinity of the building site upon which said structure is proposed to be erected. No provisions herein contained shall apply to improvements or structures within the common or recreational areas.
