
Maintenance: Lee has a proposal to repair the flooded area behind Harmony homes. The board will need a drawing and a written proposal for this project before a decision can be made.



#### ORS811.065—Unsafe passing of a person operating a bicycle -

- \* The driver of a motor vehicle must pass a bicyclist by driving to the left of the bicycle at a safe distance and return to the lane of travel once the motor vehicle is safely clear of the bicycle.
  - \* This section does not apply if:

    The cyclist is riding in a separate designated bike lane
    The motorist is traveling at 35mph or less
    The cyclist is turning left and the motorist passes on the right side.
