Some Good-to-Know Information!

- 1. Cross Creek HOA has a website that is the best source of information about all things neighborhood related. It holds our By-Laws, CC&R's, board member contact information, meeting minutes, legal documents and will be the first place residents and homeowners should go if you are looking for information. <u>crosscreekhoa.org</u>
- 2. The Rec Center is available for rent for private parties at a great rate- \$50.00 for a 6 hour rental! During the summer, you can rent the facility for a private pool party!. Summer pool rentals are available on Friday and Saturday nights from 6:30-9:00 pm and the times book up fast! Refer to the rental agreement for further information and additional rental prices.
- 3. The swimming pool typically opens the first weekend after school is out and is open seven days a week through Labor Day weekend. There are trained lifeguards on duty and staff permitting, swimming lessons are offered for in-area residents.
- 4. Sometimes there are scheduled activities for residents to enjoy, which may include: movie nights, potlucks or BBQ dinners, seasonal activities, toddler playgroup, scrapbooking or album workshops, Bunco, etc. In recent years we offered a Harvest Party Carnival that turned out to be a huge success! Most activities are free, or have a nominal fee to cover the cost of materials or labor. Check the calendar for the current month's events.
- 5. If your family has ideas for activities for children OR adults in the neighborhood, please contact the Rec Center Board or Staff members (listed in the on our website).
- 6. We are always looking for volunteer labor and materials in an effort to keep costs to the association down. If you or anyone you know is handy and would like to volunteer on occasion, please contact the Maintenance Board or Staff Members. Attending the Board Meetings is a great way to hear about upcoming projects and when/where volunteer labor is needed.
- 7. Our neighborhood has an <u>unofficial</u> Facebook page that residents may join if they choose. It is a closed group and one must request an invitation. It is a casual way to connect with neighbors and the administrator holds the ability to remove posts if they become disrespectful or violate the integrity of the page.
